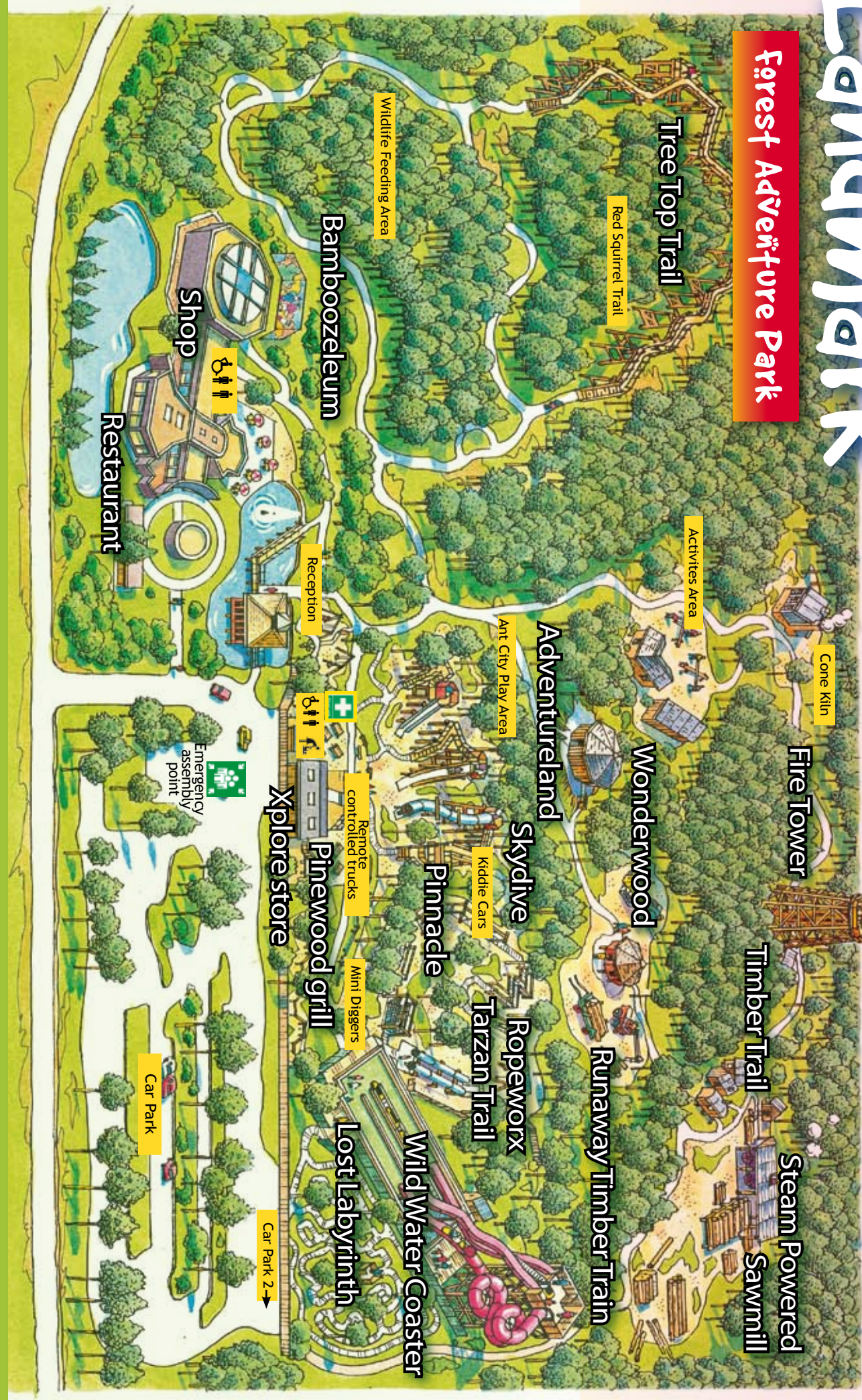


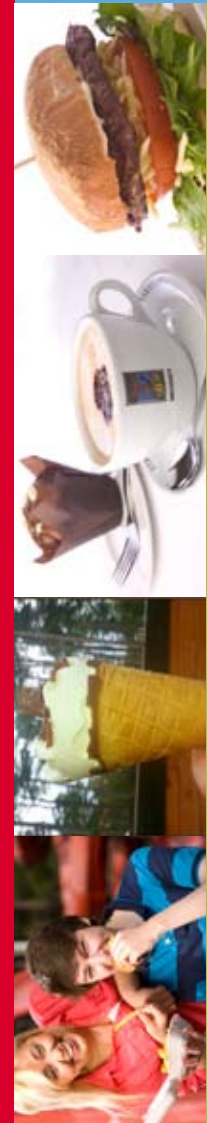

OPENING TIMES

Opening times vary - generally 10/11am until 5/6pm or 7pm in peak periods.
Please check the website for full details - www.landmarkpark.co.uk or telephone 01479 841613. Last admission to attractions 1hr before closing. Please allow 3-5 hours for your visit.

(Please note that for operational reasons managed attractions open later in the morning than the rest of the Park and some attractions close earlier than the park to allow time to clear. To avoid disappointment check local notices and try to visit the popular attractions early in your day.)

- Please be aware that on rare occasions attractions may close due to conditions outwith our control. • Unless most attractions close for a significant part of the day there will be no refunds. • Groups are very welcome - advance booking essential. Please phone ahead to allow best possible service. • In winter the Park may close due to bad weather. Please phone ahead before setting out on 01479 841613. • Disabled Access: All areas except the Ropes Courses, Skydive, Fire Tower, Watercoaster and Ant City are accessible for wheelchair. • Closed 25th December and 1st January

Skydive*

Beyond white knuckle - the ultimate dare - the ultimate achievement. (1.5m min height 17st/110kg max weight)

Pinnacle*

Conquer Landmark's 10 metre climbing wall with eight routes to beat. 17st/110kg max weight, 22"/56cm min waist)

Adventure Land

Take in the tranquillity of the 10,000 year old forest. Red Squirrel Nature Trail, Treetop Trail and wildlife feeding area. You might see a rare Red Squirrel.

Tarzan Trail*

A ropes course for little people (or larger people if they like!) set just a bit closer to the ground. (1.1m min height)
