ROUTE DESCRIPTION

Beginning in the charming village of Dunkeld, famous for its cathedral and hermitage, the route is perfect for experiencing panoramic views of rural Tayside above Ballinluig.

The route takes in the historic Victorian town of Pitlochry, which developed into a tourist resort after Queen Victoria visited the area in 1842 and bought a highland estate at Balmoral.

After leaving Pitlochry on Route 7 towards Logierait, the route joins Route 77 after crossing the well-preserved railway viaduct. The loop ends with a peaceful stretch along a delightful, traffic-free riverside path before reaching Dunkeld.
